While the chapter has not been very active, a real push will begin at the July meeting to bring in new officers and work more closely with the Idaho Chapter of the ANS (this is partially in-line with the reorganization of the ISU HP program, which recently merged with Nuclear Engineering to form the Department of Nuclear Engineering and Health Physics).
