The recently elected officers are working on several changes to reinvigorate the chapter and improve involvement. Most of these changes are in the early planning stages, with some actions already in progress:

- Increasing chapter meetings from annual to a minimum of quarterly (technical meetings when presenters are available and social meetups)
- Update and rebuild ICHPS website - Website has been updated and is in the process of being rebuilt
- Re-incorporate the Chapter (incorporation was lost in 2006) and select new board of directors
- Seek tax exemption with IRS

- Increase student involvement in the chapter and support student presentations
- Develop relationships with local secondary schools
