## Comments

The Lake Mead Chapter had a very successful year. We were able to have a technical program every month and the attendance

increased during the spring events. Our membership remains relatively inactive, but we are making inroads into attracting back to the Chapter with technical programs. In the coming year, our emphasis on increasing membership participation will be a top priority. Our membership suffered quite a loss with the severe reduction in Yucca Mountain activities since many members moved out of town to get other jobs. We had no candidates for elections this year, so we decided to retain the same officers for the next year. This is a direct function of the loss of active members related to the Yucca Mountain debacle. The Chapter was instrumental in two major outreach programs. The Nuclear Science Boy Scout Merit Badge program was very successful. We ran the first two iterations of the class in November 08 and May 09. The result was that 45 Boy Scouts earned the Nuclear Science merit badge. We are committed to supporting this event, but will go to once a year in 2010 because we have less demand because so many Scouts have received the merit badge. Our members continue to be active in the National HPS and we have a very strong student section. In addition, we held a CHP test at our meeting room on the campus of UNLV in July 08 and will host another one in July 09. In an effort to increase our public outreach, we have opened our monthly technical meetings to the general public. We have had a marginal success with this and it adds an average of 10 people to our attendance list.
