Gautman is a science research student of Ms. Donna Armani, a 2005 HPS Outstanding Science Teacher Award winner. Notification of his being selected for the HPS Science Student Award was received from the HPS Awards Committee in June 2011. 2 - The Virginia Chapter continued with preliminary discussions with the faculty and administration of the Central Virginia Community College (CVCC) in Lynchburg, VA concerning the formation of a Student HPS Chapter. A draft Constitution for the CVCC Student Chapter has been prepared and undergone several rounds of review.
