The CRMC also has met jointly with the NIOSH Mountain and Plains Education and Research Center and invites local NRRPT Registrants and ANS members, as well as the University of Colorado Anschutz campus community to attend our meetings. Dr. Thomas E. Johnson, CSU Student Branch Advisor is an energizing force for both the Branch and Chapter. This collaboration and joint meeting of the CRMCHPS, HPS CSU Student Branch, NIOSH MAP ERC, NRRPT, and ANS has been very successful for our Chapter. The NIOSH MAP ERC has provided some funding for the meetings which allows us to have a light dinner and social hour before each evening meeting at no cost to the students while keeping the cost for other attendees at approximately \$10. Most meetings are held at the Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora, CO, but we aim to hold at least one meeting at the CU Boulder Campus each year. As is traditional for our Chapter, its Spring Annual technical meeting was held at the Student Center of CSU. The focus of the Spring technical meeting is presentations by the CSU Health Physics students with cash prizes awarded to the top three speakers. President-elect Barbara Hamrick was the final

speaker of the day, following a social hour and dinner. For the second year, we held a Fall Technical Meeting to allow members of the chapter to give short presentations. In October, the Fall Technical Meeting included a tour of the new University of Colorado Hospital Emergency Department and presentations that focused on Emergency Preparedness for Radiological Events.
