Dr. Gary Zeman is the radiological safety officer at Argonne National Laboratory and has over 30 years of health physics experience in research, industrial, and military applications. Gary formerly served as radiation control manager for Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory. Before entering the US Department of Energy (DOE) complex, Gary held the position of manager of Radiation Protection and Product Safety at AT&T Bell Labs (now Lucent Technologies) in New Jersey and served a 20-year career as a radiation health officer in the US Navy, Medical Service Corps. Gary is an expert on radiation measurements and personnel dosimetry and currently is a member of the Advisory Board on Veterans Dose Reconstruction. In the past, Gary has served the Health Physics Society (HPS) as newsletter editor and website “Ask the Experts” contributor in the area of non-ionizing radiation.
